# Surfers Paradise

## AIRPORT – HIKKADUWA

On arrival the guests will be met at the airport arrival lobby and set off to Hikkaduwa.

Hikkaduwa is the main surf destination and attracts surfers from Australia, UK, Japan, USA and many more countries. There are up to 4 main surf points with clear, warm water in the Hikkaduwa area.

Although most of them are reef breaks, none of them are risky. All spots have a deep bottom and flat reef.

The size of the waves range from 2 to 7 feet during the season time. The main point is called "main reef" which has a "A" frame shaped wave which surfers can ride both the right hander and a left hander. One of the main reasons for Hikkaduwa's popularity is due to the selection of budget and luxury accommodation.

Hikkaduwa was a fishing village 30 years ago, since the early 1980's it has become one of the major tourist attractions in Sri Lanka. Hikkaduwa is famous among tourists for its natural beauty, wide sandy beaches, marine reserve, crystal clear waters and hot sun make it a desired destination on the south coast of Sri Lanka. Tourists stream to Hikkaduwa mainly for the range of water sports like surfing, scuba diving, kite surfing and much more.

**Benny's** – This is the classic left hander on a reef break and this is south of Hikkaduwa town.

Good for the more experienced surfers. When the main point of Hikkaduwa goes over 6ft the surfing conditions are superb

The Main Point ( main reef ) - the most popular surf breaks in the island with left and right hander waves.

It is reef bottomed but safe due to depth. Height can range anything from 2ft up to 10ft on a good day. 1.5km from Hikkaduwa town.

### The Rock

Located 40mins south of Hikkaduwa close to bay of Unawatuna. One can ride both left handers as well as right handers, but the locals will tell that left handers are more popular. Waves can reach up to 8ft.

#### Plantation Point

It is located 50mins south of Hikkaduwa in the laid-back village of Weligama. Perfect shaped waves with reef breaks. It is ideal for beginners as well as the most experienced surfer. Waves on a good day can reach up to 6ft.

### Polhena

One and half hour drive to south of Hikkaduwa we find Polhena, another fishing village which has two surf breaks in the area. Both of them are reef bottomed and fast waves around 6ft.

Other than the above mentioned surf spots there number of "secret spots" that will be at your disposal

## ARUGAM BAY

Arugam Bay is located at the end of the road on the East Coast of Sri Lanka. If you're after remote rural life with all the atmosphere of jungle and adventure this is the place for you. Arugam Bay is listed as one of the top ten surf points in the world. Situated on the southeast of Sri Lanka, Arugam Bay receives the same Antarctic winter swells that hit Indonesia's southern shores in the middle of the year. The Best time of the year for surf is between May and November when the predominant wind is off shore for at least the first half of the day.

Long, well lined up right point break over sharp. Wave size is 2 – 8ft

### Peanut Farm

20 minutes South of Arugam Bay. Right sandy pink breaks (some times tubes). Wave size 2 – 6ft

#### Potuvil Point

15 minutes North of Arugam Bay. The second best point of Sri Lanka's East Coast. Right sandy point break. Wave size 2 – 6ft. The best wave can ride up to 700m.

### Crocodile Rock

15 minutes South of Arugam Bay. Right sand point break off a river mouth. Wave size 2 – 3.5ft.

### Okanda Poiny

Right sandy point break about 15-18 km from Arugam Bay. Long ride waves.

**Mirissa**

A surfing hot spot in Sri Lanka, Mirissa beach offers waves for nice turns. Morning period is the best. The beach is clean and clear and a great start off point for a run in to the waters. The blue waters offer good ride for the beginners and experienced surfers. Mirissa beach is an unpopulated beach.

Mirissa is a pointbreak location with the intermediate level waves. Local surfers can be considered to be average To good. Best waves can be experienced early morning and late afternoon. Directiona are right hand and short length. Mirissa is known as one of the major surf points in Sri Lanka. Compared to Hikkaduwa surfing is still fun without real line ups and consistent waves.

Best times for surfing in Mirissa is from October - March.

**Unawatuna Surfing**

In the Unawatuna area are some excellent reef breaks that are well worth investigating. The surf conditions in Unawatuna are ideal for beginners, too. If you want to learn surfing you can hire a local instructor and get started right away. Early morning offshores are best and the sun does not get in your eyes.

**Ahangama Surfing**

In the Ahangama area are some excellent reef breaks that are well worth investigating. The surf conditions in Ahangama are ideal for beginners, too. If you want to learn surfing you can hire a local instructor and get started right away. Early morning offshores are best and the sun does not get in your eyes. Koggal and Ahangama are catering for all tastes. Great surf breaks, uncrowded beaches and an amazing wildlife just a few minutes from the sea.
